Snacks:

We will not be providing snacks since our time falls before or after dinner. However, on occasions to celebrate we may have snacks and at that time we may ask for volunteers to bring in food and drinks.

Fees:

The Girl Scout Registration fee is \$15 and our troop activity fee is \$10. A check made payable to Girl Scout Troop 3063 should be paid by September 2nd. The activity fee should help offset craft and activity costs along with providing your child with books, badges, and awards. If we decide to do anything above and beyond, we will discuss additional fees at that time. We will review the activity fee at times to ensure that costs are being covered by the troop, but we will do what we can to keep your costs as low as possible.

Adult Volunteers:

Volunteers are always welcome and to the volunteers already involved... Thank you. If you would like to be active in our Girl Scout meetings, then you have to become a Girl Scout. There are 2 forms to fill out...one for the Volunteer Application and the other is the Adult Registration form similar to the Girl Scout Registration form. The adult must also pay the \$15 fee.

We do ask that 1 adult signup with each girl (or family), so that there is never any issue with volunteering or attending events.

Uniforms:

Please see the attached uniform sheet to see what parents need to purchase themselves. We do have a store in Columbus at 1300 Hutchins Ave. that is open Tuesday thru Friday from 12:00 pm to 5:00 pm and Saturday from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm.

Attendance:

We hope that your daughter will be able to attend every meeting, but understand that scheduling can be difficult with sports and other activities. The girls will be doing activities and crafts that will earn badges and awards. If you have to miss a meeting, please get with your troop leader so that your child keeps up with the others. You should also check emails and the website for any special information you may have missed at the meeting.

Safety:

Please fill out the enclosed form with drop-off/pick-up information. If someone other than a parent/guardian will be bringing or picking up your child, please let your troop leader know in advance. For your child's safety, no child may be dropped off in the parking lot, nor will they be released unless a parent is present to pick up or other arrangements have been made in advance.

Illness/Lice:

Since the girls will be doing activities and crafts where germs can be easily spread, please do not bring a sick child to Girl Scouts. If your child did not go to school that day, please don't bring them to the meeting. Also if your child has head lice, please keep them home.

Parking:

Please only park in designated parking spaces between the marked lines. Also do not park in the handicap parking. Thank you!

What do parents do during the meetings?:

We will be utilizing all of Fellowship Hall this year, so parents may not stay in this area during the meetings. Registered parents are welcome to help the leader with the group. Please ask the leader if they need help...some leaders set up a schedule for this. Also no siblings are allowed in meetings. If you would like to stay at the church during the meeting, the library and playroom are open on the second floor. Please pickup promptly at 7:30. Also please do not doddle and visit after the meetings. Many leaders are trying to clean up and get home...a lot of times they haven't been home that day or had dinner. 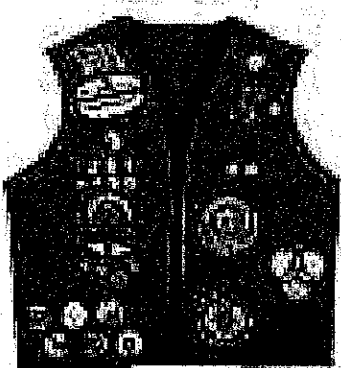

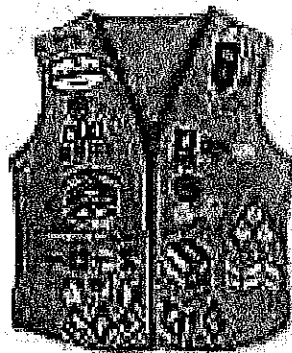

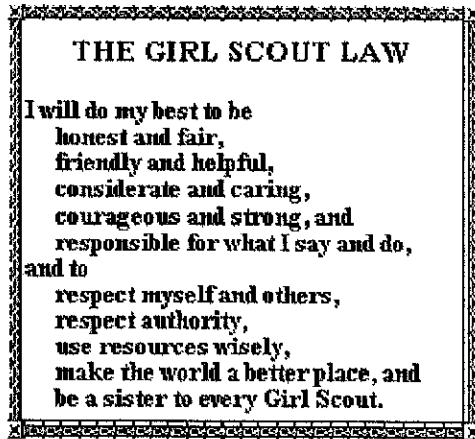

Troop 3063 Super Scout Award

Girl Scout Troop 3063 wants to recognize the Girl Scout who goes above and beyond in representing a point of the Girl Scout Law. We created the Super Scout Award to recognize this exceptional behavior.

Each Girl Scout who receives the award will be given a plaque at the Bridging Ceremony in May each year. There will also be a larger plaque kept on the wall in Fellowship Hall at First United Methodist Church that shows each recipient's name and year of the award.

The first award was presented in May 2013, to Emily Wessel for representing the part of the law that asks a Girl Scout to "be a sister to every scout" by making and running a very special pinewood derby car for one of her fellow scouts who had to move out of state just before the race. The May 2014 recipient was Jessyka Brown who "made the world a better place" by helping and encouraging other children to complete a community race.

Leaders will choose the Girl Scout who will receive the Super Scout Award each spring. If you spot a Girl Scout who is going above and beyond one of the points of the Law, please point her and the action out to a leader to be considered for the award.

How money is earned:

Fall Product Sales (Nuts & Chocolates) is based on the dollar (\$) amount that your daughter sells.

\$50 - \$99.99 in sales = \$5 in Girl Account

\$100 or more in sales = \$10 in Girl Account

Cookie Sales is based on the number of boxes that your daughter sells.

50 - 99 boxes = \$5 in Girl Account

100 - 149 boxes = \$10 in Girl Account

150 - 199 boxes = \$15 in Girl Account

200 or more boxes = \$20 in Girl Account

Your daughter will be able to earn a total of \$30 per year in the Girl Account by meeting these goals.

How money can be used:

The monies can be used on certain events throughout the year. The event registrations will be noted if the Girl Account can be used.

If you register for a Girl Scout event on your own (not a troop event), you may be reimbursed for this if you provide proof of registration and proof of attendance. Please see Sarah Campbell for this.

This money is not "real". It is not yours, if you leave our troop or transfer to another troop. If you leave our troop for a year and then return, your balance will be reset to \$0.

Monies cannot be used for Girl Scout Registration, Adult Scout Registration or Troop Dues.

The money does roll-over from one year to the next. We will provide account balances occasionally, but you may inquire at any time. Please contact Jennifer Hatchett with questions.

GS Promise & Law Live It!

Code of Conduct:

As Girl Scout troop leaders, we take seriously the role you have given us when you entrusted the health, safety, and welfare of your daughter to us as a member of this Girl Scout troop. In turn, we ask that your daughter(s):

1. I will follow the principles of the Girl Scout Promise and Law.
2. I will follow the rules that are made to protect others and myself and to help make sure program activities are safe, fun and successful.
3. I will treat other people, myself, property, and equipment with respect.
4. I will not behave in such a manner that monopolizes the time of the Troop Leader or Assistant Leader and jeopardizes the Girl Scout experience for the entire troop.
5. I will not bully or abuse my sister Girl Scouts.
6. I will listen carefully to all instructions and appropriately respond to all directions given by the Girl Scout Leader and all Assistant Leaders.
7. I will be respectful of the Girl Scout Leader and all Assistant Leaders. I will not argue with my leader or call them names while under their supervision.
8. I will remain seated, or with the group depending on the activity, unless excused by the Girl Scout Leader or an Assistant Leader and keep my hands to myself during all Troop/Event activities. I will not run inside buildings or meeting places.

Failure to follow our Code of Conduct will result in the following corrective action:

First Offense: written warning handed to parent (page outlines all 3 steps)

Second Offense: written warning that requires a parent to sit with child at next meeting

Third Offense: written warning (or after parent sits in) requires child to skip next meeting and review her desire to be a Girl Scout, give paper with the Law and what it means to them
